Landscaping

1. **Personal Protective Equipment** for Landscapers include: Hard hats, Safety glasses, Construction shirts, construction pants and construction boots.



2. Juniperus Bermudiana is a species of juniper endemic to Bermuda. This species is most commonly known as Bermuda cedar, but is also referred to as Bermuda juniper.



3. **Silver buttonwood** is a member of the (*Combretaceae*) family has velvety-soft leaves dusted with silvery-gray color and makes a stunning hedge, accent or small tree.



4. *Hibiscus* is a genus of <u>flowering plants</u> in the <u>mallow</u> family, <u>Malvaceae</u>. The genus is quite large, comprising <u>several hundred species</u> that are <u>native</u> to warm <u>temperate</u>, <u>subtropical</u> and <u>tropical</u> regions throughout the world.



5. Palm Trees (Arecaceae) are a botanical <u>family</u> of perennial trees, <u>climbers</u>, shrubs, and acaules commonly known as **palm trees** (owing to historical usage, the family is alternatively called **Palmae**).



6. **St. Augustine grass** (*Stenotaphrum secundatum*) (also known as **Charleston grass** in South Carolina and **buffalo turf** in Australia) is a warm-season <u>lawn grass</u> that is popular for cultivation in <u>tropical</u> and <u>subtropical</u> regions.



- 7. Bermuda grass (Cynodon dactylon), also known as Vilfa stellata^[2] dūrvā grass, Dhoob, is a grass that originated in the Middle East.^[4] Although it is not native to Bermuda, it is an abundant invasive species arriving in North America from Bermuda, resulting in its name.
